Over the years, this series has become a very popular one with collectors. Some of the early sets such as the *Chessie Steam Special* are selling for 6 to 7 times the original retail price.



This special set of one of the "Original" *Daylight* trains dates to 1941. The first group of the GS-4 series of 4-8-4 steam engines was delivered to the railroad during April and May of 1941, and the tender carried the lettering "Southern Pacific Lines" which matched the wording on the Daylight passenger cars then in service. Shortly thereafter the lettering on the engines and cars was changed to just "Southern Pacific". Thus you can distinguish this collectors set from our normal production items by the difference in the lettering.

As a help to those of you who are following the series, a complete list of all of the sets previously released is in the right hand column.

If you are interested in looking for some of these older sets, your best bet is to check on Ebay, or at model railroad shows in your area. We have none of the early sets left to sell at the factory.
